Present Wording:
ARTICLE 2. MEMBERS
SECTION 7. Mossyback. Mossyback is defined as any member with a minimum of ten (10) years
active membership in the Las Vegas Corvettes Association. Upon completion of said members' tenth
anniversary, he/she may make application for membership. All "Mossyback" activities shall be
conducted within the framework of the Las Vegas Corvettes Association.

SECTION 7. Longevity Recognition. Honorary individual titles will be bestowed upon members who
have remained members of the LVCA for specified durations. Credit for membership duration is
defined in Article 12, Sections 2 and 3.

SECTION 7. (a) Mossyback. Mossyback is defined as any member with a minimum of ten (10) years

SECTION 7. (b) Silverback. The honorary title of Silverback will be bestowed upon any individual
with a minimum of twenty-five (25) years membership in the Las Vegas Corvettes Association.
