Subject: Silverback description

By-Laws/Standing Rules: Article: 2 Section: 7

Present Wording:

ARTICLE 2. MEMBERS

SECTION 7. Mossyback. Mossyback is defined as any member with a minimum of ten (10) years active membership in the Las Vegas Corvettes Association. Upon completion of said members' tenth anniversary, he/she may make application for membership. All "Mossyback" activities shall be conducted within the framework of the Las Vegas Corvettes Association.

Recommended amendment:

ARTICLE 2. MEMBERS

SECTION 7. Longevity Recognition. Honorary individual titles will be bestowed upon members who have remained members of the LVCA for specified durations. Credit for membership duration is defined in Article 12, Sections 2 and 3.

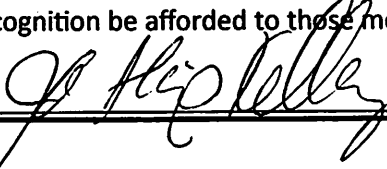
SECTION 7. (a) Mossyback. Mossyback is defined as any member with a minimum of ten (10) years active membership in the Las Vegas Corvettes Association. Upon completion of said members' tenth anniversary, he/she may make application for membership. All "Mossyback" activities shall be conducted within the framework of the Las Vegas Corvettes Association.

SECTION 7. (b) Silverback. The honorary title of Silverback will be bestowed upon any individual with a minimum of twenty-five (25) years membership in the Las Vegas Corvettes Association.

Justification:

This would be an addition to SECTION 7 defining an honorary individual title for 25 year members of the LVCA.

The LVCA has existed for over 45 years now. It is right and customary to honor those in an organization who have contributed to the growth and development of that organization. As we approach 50 years in the LVCA, it's only right that special recognition be afforded to those members who have remained a part of it for more than half its existence.
