2nd Ever Drag Workshop

We will be having our 2nd Ever Drag Workshop on Friday, February. 24th, to help out anyone who wants help. For the experienced drag racers, this is a great opportunity to shake out the cobwebs and warm up before our first Drag Series event on Saturday, February 25th. Here is the plan.

Meet at the Iron Skillet at 5 pm, inside Petro's Truck Stop which is right off I-15 Exit 54, Speedway Blvd. exit, north of town. This will give us a chance, well, to eat, but also to talk about what everyone would like to accomplish that night and what we can do to help. We will be available to ride along with you, or you could ride along with us. We can also hook you up with tips and tricks. Around 6:30, we will mosey down the street and get in line for Midnight Mayhem.

Although this event is designed to get kids who do illegal street racing off the street and into a safe and legal environment, but it's open to anyone who wants to come do some runs. Their rules are a little different than they will be when we compete on Saturday. Helmets are required if you go faster than 14 seconds. They check your driver's license, registration (no temporary tags) and proof of insurance. The car must be street legal. No coolers, alcohol or weapons - they check the trunk or back area. Entry fee is \$15 to race or ride along and \$5 admission for spectators.

If you want to skip dinner and just practice, try to meet us at the truck stop anyway so we can stay together when we go to the track.
