


Drag Workshop

For our 2nd drag workshop this year, we will once again meet at the Iron Skillet at the Petro truck stop at the Speedway Blvd. exit, Exit 54 from I-15, at 5 pm for dinner and discussion. Then we will head over to the drag strip and get in line to practice at the Midnight Mayhem. Or you can join us just for dinner or just for the practice. Everyone is invited - first timers through experienced. Come out and learn to drag race, come out to practice, and/or come out to help the beginners.





Entry fee \$15. Must have driver's license, registration, proof of insurance and a helmet if you do the 1/4 mile in less than 13 seconds.

3rd Ever Drag Workshop

We will be having our 3rd Ever Drag Workshop on Friday, April. 27th, to help out anyone who wants help. This is another warm-up and a chance to practice our launches before the May 5th drag. Here is the plan.

Meet at the Iron Skillet at 5 pm, inside Petro's Truck Stop which is right off I-15 Exit 54, Speedway Blvd. exit, north of town. This will give us a chance, well, to eat, but also to talk about what everyone would like to accomplish that night and what we can do to help. We will be available to ride along with you, or you could ride along with us. We can also hook you up with tips and tricks. Around 6:40, we will mosey down the street and get in line for Midnight Mayhem.

Although this event is designed to get kids who do illegal street racing off the street and into a safe and legal environment, but it's open to anyone who wants to come do some runs. Their rules are a little different than they will be when we compete on Saturday. Helmets are required if you go faster than 14 seconds. They check your driver's license, registration (no temporary tags) and proof of insurance. The car must be street legal. No coolers, alcohol or weapons - they check the trunk or back area. Entry fee is \$15 to race or ride along and \$5 admission for spectators.

If you want to skip dinner and just practice, try to meet us at the truck stop anyway so we can stay together when we go to the track.
